Quartet Coaching

The HX quartet coaching program is designed to help the students improve what they are already doing. The quartets get coaching from the best that the Northeast has to offer. These coaches offer insight on visual presentation, vocal production, and all around having fun. Students have found these coaching sessions to be very beneficial.

The quartet coaching is an optional activity, in addition to working with the HX chorus. Students who want quartet coaching can either attend with an existing quartet, or request in advance to be put into a group coaching activity with other HX attendees. The quartet coaching program consists of a coaching session, and an informal performance opportunity combined with constructive feedback. This is a great experience that we're sure you'll enjoy--if you have any questions about it please contact the Camp Coordinator listed below.

Students who are not in the coaching program will have a group activity with the teaching quartet during that time period.

Music Educators

There is also a Professional Development Curriculum at Harmony Extreme Camp. Music educators attend seminars given by the clinicians that work with the students. Topics will include warm-ups, vocal production, directing techniques, quartet coaching, riser placement, non-verbal communication and the conductor, recruiting for your chorus, and more. You'll also be able to select a class of interest to you from the Harmony College Northeast curriculum, which runs parallel to the HX Camp. A course selection listing will be sent to all music educators in advance. Also, back by popular demand, will be the educator chorus. The music educators and collegiate music education students will be formed into a mixed chorus. Music will be sent in advance.

Our staff handles all the chaperoning duties so that the music educators are not burdoned in any way.

Collegiate MENC Students and Music Education Majors

Members of Collegiate MENC Chapters, and other music education majors also attend HX Camp. They take the full Professional Development Curriculum. This is a great opportunity for future music educators.
