1. Letter from the Executive Vice President

On January 28th, the **NED House of Delegates** voted unanimously in favor of open contests for District and Division champions. On February 9th, the Society Board of Directors announced that the International Quartet and Chorus contests would be open as well. An exciting new age has dawned for our District and our Society – from this day forward, all ensembles, whether they identify as male, female, or all-voice/mixed, will compete head-to-head, and the best will be our champions.

While we will continue to preserve the history and heritage of our great society and this wonderful art form, we now all have the opportunity to encourage new members, and new ensembles, to join us as equals without discrimination, without partisanship. We can now truly live up to the ideals of **Everyone in Harmony**, and be a fellowship of singers - no labels attached.



One thing that these decisions do not change is each ensemble's right to determine their own identity. The day to day life of our Chapters is not impacted by decisions about contest structure. Only (roughly) 30% of our members who typically compete will experience these changes in person, and then for only a few days a year while competing.

The fellowship we enjoy in this hobby comes largely from the ensembles we're members of, and that is not changing.

But for those that, prior to these decisions, were marginalized or left out all together, the difference is monumental, and I am very happy that we can be their singing home now as well.

I am also proud to be able to say that the NED led the way in inclusivity. Now let's all get together in Hyannis and Queensbury this April and celebrate it!

2. International Conventions to have open quartet, chorus competitions

On Monday, February 7, 2022, the Barbershop Harmony Society Board of Directors voted unanimously in a historic decision to open its annual International contest to all quartets and choruses, without gender distinctions. The vote followed more than eight months of engagement with members and barbershop leaders.

The Board's decision continues to recognize the freedom of Society chapter leaders and quartets to decide the composition of their singing groups. They may opt to continue with all-male



groups, all-female groups, all-voice groups, or any combination of those, in alignment with the Society's 2017 strategic plan, which encouraged broader diversity of all types across singing communities.

Passport applications right now require 8-11 weeks for processing - renewals are a bit faster. Expedited processing (higher fee) is 5-8 weeks out! Don't wait until the last minute!
