1. Letter from the ... **VP of Contest and Judging**

A YEAR OF CONTESTS IS BEHIND US

As we are all aware, the COVID pandemic really whacked our chapters in our efforts to gather, rehearse and perform. Not much of the first (except by Zoom), less of the second (rehearsing on Zoom was less than desirable), and virtually none of the latter. So, when we decided to hold the **District Fall Convention and Contests** in October 2021, it was with bated breath not knowing how many would attend. Turns out the attendance and participation were greater than we had anticipated. Clearly, we all wanted and needed to get together, see old friends, share some music, and celebrate our partial escape from the virus.

All of this in the midst of a sea change in our contest system where we broke new ground and welcomed and accommodated new quartets and choruses in the mixed harmony and women's sections. NED formed a committee to study the changes that needed to be made and the House of Delegates adopted those changes UNANIMOUSLY! We now have room under our contest tent for literally every form of performing group. And the proof of that shown brightly during our **Eastern Regional** and **Western Regional** Conventions this

spring with multiple mixed harmony quartets, multiple mixed harmony choruses, and a women's quartet. Not only did they represent themselves well but in several instances won championships in both the quartet and chorus contests.

The two spring conventions included 14 choruses, 3 Very Large Quartets, and 26 quartets. Unfortunately, we lost two choruses and two quartets to COVID. However, we determined (invoking COVID Protocols #18 and #19) that we would allow those four groups to participate in the Fall Contest since they had worked as hard as anyone else to prepare and were struck by the great virus equalizer.



As far as I know right now, the 16 choruses, 3 Very Large Quartets, and 22 qualifying quartets all plan to be in **Saint John** on October 22-24. And our brothers and sisters in the **Sunrise Division** (Canadian maritime provinces), who haven't had a division convention in three years now (since Spring 2019,) are all eligible to participate in the Fall - even without their **Sunrise Division** contest. What does that mean? Perhaps as many as 20 choruses, 3 or 4 Very Large Quartets, and 25-30 quartets to delight and entertain you in **Saint John**, **NB**. We will be naming and celebrating various quartet and chorus championships, qualifying our representative chorus(es) for the **2023 International Chorus Contest** and qualifying our representative seniors quartet(s)

for the **2023 International Seniors Quartet Contest** in January.

As far as qualification for International contests goes, it was a great year. We qualified several groups and had a few 'near misses'. I don't remember any time in the last 40 years where we had as many qualifiers from NED as we had in the last 12 months:

Seniors Quartet Contest (January 2022): Duly Noted / Off The Chart / Port City Sound / Trade Secret

Chorus Contest (July 2022): Vocal Revolution

(Just missing the cut by 1 point): Voices United

Quartet Contest (July 2022): Daily Special / Greenlight / Points North / Sweet & Sour

(Just missing the cut by 4 points): **Destination**

What a great year this has been as we try to return to 'normal'. I fully anticipate that the coming year will be even better with more chapters awakening from the slumber of the COVID winter and begin to remember what it was we enjoyed so much about singing.




