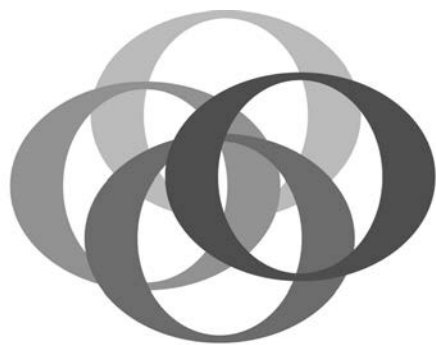

General Information - All Contests

Let us not interfere with the performers on-stage - or disturb others around us, please.

No FLASH/ No NOISE photography

Cameras alone or in cell phones can use focusing/capture lights and make noise. Best to leave these items in your pocket.



Quiet Please! All devices = volume OFF!

Please turn OFF all devices. You don't need those now! Smoking & "drinking" is prohibited at all times in all areas. Food & beverage is NOT allowed in the auditorium... Bottled water is OK.



Admittance during Contest

Your auditorium entry and exit is permitted *between* competitors during the contest session - do so quickly and quietly. Competitors will not be introduced while people are moving about the auditorium.



No Recordings - Audio or Video

Copyright law strictly limits the use of audio or video recording during any performance. No camera, audio or video device is permitted to record performances without permission of the District. Any person found using a device to record will be required to stop. The recording medium or device may be confiscated and unauthorized recordings removed. Enforcement of the copyright law protects you and us; but most importantly, it protects the copyright owners who make our music and performances possible.
